

## **Recommended Attributes of Persons Delivering the Offertory**

The offertory is an opportunity to share the many blessings that God has bestowed upon us. When asked to deliver the offertory, many people consider it a “duty” or “obligation” rather than an important and integral part of the worship service.

In an effort to ensure that offertories have maximum effectiveness, the following attributes are offered as guidelines. They are not meant to stifle the process when choosing those who will participate in delivering offertories. It is helpful if the person chosen to deliver the offertory exhibits many of the following attributes.

- Desires to participate in the offertory
- Plans ahead by working with the pastor and/or worship team to ensure the offertory is connected to the worship service being planned
- Is knowledgeable about *Disciple's Generous Response* principles
- Contributes to Congregation Ministries and World Ministries Mission Tithes
- Is genuine, engaging and can relate to all generations in the congregation
- Communicates effectively
- Is comfortable sharing their testimony
- Is able to use story, drama or visual aids
