Youth Activities Policies

- Every camper must have registered online by parent/ guardian with fees paid or payment arranged before attending camp.
- Copy of insurance card can be brought at time of drop-off.
- We have a CLOSED CAMP policy which means staff and campers must remain at the activity or campsite for the duration of the camp. Any questions regarding policy may be directed to Camp Directors and Mission Center Staff.
- Because God calls us to create sacred community with each other, campers and staff are called to uphold the values of Community of Christ and behave in ways that promote a community of faith.
- Clothing should be appropriate for a Community of Christ Camp..
- Personal electronics (phones, iPods, etc.) can be used at Camp Directors discretion (i.e. during quiet time).
- No Weapons, fireworks, alcohol, tobacco, illegal drug use, or anything else that may distract from community building.
- Midlands Mission Center, campgrounds, and/or camp staff cannot be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.



Covid-19 Related Expectations

- All participants should refrain from attending high risk events, i.e. large, unmasked indoor gatherings, for 10 days prior to camp.
- All participants should bring an individual, refillable water bottle for personal use.
- All participants with an elevated temperature and/or other COVID-19 symptoms will be expected to self-isolate until they may be picked up.
